Friends – Play for Disabled Children

Due to the ongoing Coronavirus pandemic "Friends play for disabled children" issue the following guidance for ALL family members.

For all events Friends will be operating under the respective venues COVID-19 Policy & guidelines. Families will be expected to sign in or check in where relevant for Track & Trace.

Where events are held indoors we will ensure that hand gel is available for use.

It is the responsibility of parents to provide their own face masks for family members over the age of 10, unless medically exempt.

Please remember that some venues may require proof of medical exemption if attending an event, it is parental responsibility to provide this if questioned.

May we remind ALL parents that their children are their responsibility and as such they are responsible for ensuring that the relevant Covid-19 guidelines like social distancing measures need to be adhered to.

Upon attending an event if a family member falls ill and is diagnosed with a confirmed case of coronavirus within the family, it is parental responsibility to notify the charity immediately so that we can notify other families whom also attended the same event.

Please ensure that if you have recently changed your mobile phone numbers or email address that admin are notified so that we have your latest contact details should we need to use them in an emergency.

If you or any member of your family are displaying symptoms or feel unwell on the day of an event please do not attend.

Cancellation policy - A full refund will be issued If an event is cancelled by the venue.
